## Who We Are

- Howard County Health Department's Bureau of Behavioral Health
- Howard County Local Addiction Authority

## Services

- **Opioid Misuse Prevention Program (OMPP)**  
Opioid prevention and awareness through social media, training and information sharing
- **Overdose Response Program (ORP)**  
Training and certification to administer naloxone to reverse an opioid overdose
- **Resource and Referral Services**  
Linkage to outpatient, detoxification, and inpatient substance use disorder treatment

- **Peer Recovery Support Services**  
Individuals in recovery provide support, encouragement and advocate for others seeking and maintaining recovery
- **State Care Coordination**  
Linkages and referrals to community resources that assist individuals in remaining engaged in their recovery
- **Maryland Recovery Net (MDRN) Care Coordination**  
Provides vouchers and referrals for a variety of services including recovery housing, counseling, transportation and job skills training
- **Howard County Department of Social Services, Alcohol/Drug screenings for Temporary Cash Assistance Recipients**  
Substance use disorder screening and treatment referral services for individuals eligible for Temporary Cash Assistance
- **Howard County Detention Center, Outpatient Treatment**  
Outpatient substance use disorder treatment provided at the Howard County Detention Center

## Local Addiction Authority

The Local Addiction Authority plans, manages, and monitors the publicly funded substance use disorder services in Howard County.
